Arts Legacy for Organizations & Communities grant funding still available for FY2011

SMAHC has added a third round of funding for the Arts Legacy for Organizations & Communities grant program. This program is intended to fund high-quality projects or activities that will create a strong arts legacy in southwest Minnesota. Funding is available to organizations and communities in our 18-county region for up to \$20,000. Applicants who wish to apply for grants of \$10,000 to \$20,000 must submit a pre-application. Applicants whose pre-application aligns with SMAHC Arts Legacy Grant program objectives and shows considerable potential will then be invited to submit a full grant application.

The Minnesota State Arts Board and Minnesota's designated regional arts councils are entrusted with stewardship of significant new funding through the State of Minnesota's Arts and Cultural Heritage (ACH) Fund. Proceeds from the fund may be spent only on arts and arts access, arts learning and art and cultural heritage.

New Legacy Logo Usage Regulations

Did you know... that MOST of our grant programs and **ALL of SMAHC's workshops and sponsored art-learning events** are made possible with funding by the MN Arts & Cultural Heritage Fund as appropriated by the MN State Legislature with money from the vote of the people on MN on November 4, 2008.

This "Legacy Amendment" funding has a new logo that you will see on the SMAHC website, grant guidelines, and event/workshop notices.

It is required by law to be shown on any promotion or advertising by grant recipients who have received funding through the Legacy grant programs.

The following acknowledgement is required to accompany this logo on any printed materials or digital promotions & advertising:

"This activity is made possible in part by a grant from the Southwest Minnesota Arts & Humanities Council (SMAHC) with funds from the Minnesota Arts and Cultural Heritage Fund as appropriated by the Minnesota State Legislature with money from the Legacy Amendment vote of the people of Minnesota on November 4, 2008."

These requirements apply to all printed materials, news releases, newsletters, advertisements, postcards, posters, programs, catalogs, invitations, films, videotapes, electronic transmissions and Internet sites. Grantees must also acknowledge this funding even when written credit is not applicable, by providing oral credit before each event or performance.

All variations of the logo, in multiple file formats, are available on the Department of Natural Resources website at: www.dnr.state.mn.us/legacylogo/

As a recipient of legacy funds:

- The logo must be used as is, without further design or format alteration.
- The logo can only be used to represent official Legacy Amendment projects.

SMAHC awards Arts Legacy for Organizations & Communities Grants

At the February 22 meeting, the SMAHC Board of Directors voted to award a total of \$47,299 under the Arts Legacy for Organizations & Communities grant program.

The Arts Legacy for Organizations & Communities grant program awards up to \$20,000 for projects that leave an arts legacy. Four grant recipients received the following funding:

RiverSong Music Festival, Hutchinson: \$10,974 to offset festival expenses

Marshall Area Fine Arts Council, Marshall: \$20,000 for the creation/painting of a history mural in downtown Marshall

Marshall-Lyon County Library, Marshall: \$12,750 to create drawings etched on glass windows in the entry of the new Marshall library now under construction

Chippewa Valley Youth Club, Montevideo: \$3,575 to form a youth ukulele orchestra
