ARTS ORGANIZATION DEVELOPMENT

Provides arts organizations in the SMAC region with up to **\$2,500** in matching funds to increase their long-term stability and capacity through organizational development and management projects. 20% cash match required.

ARTS ORGANIZATION START-UP

Provides arts organizations with at least two years of programming up to **\$2,000** to develop articles of incorporation, by-laws, and apply for their 501(c)(3) status. No cash match required.

EQUIPMENT / FACILITIES IMPROVEMENT

Provides arts organizations with up to **\$10,000** in matching funds for the purchase of equipment items and facilities improvements that will strengthen the organization's capacity to serve the arts needs of the SMAC region. 20% cash match required.

Up to **\$4,000** (artist residencies) or **\$2,500** (field trips, juried exhibits, or prepackaged theatre). 20% cash match for prepackaged theater only.

Costs for standard weekly lessons are allowed for students who qualify for the federal free or reduced lunch program. Arts supplies costs are allowed for students attending a MN public arts high school. No match requirements.

INDIVIDUAL ARTIST: EMERGING

Provides up to **\$2,500** to aid emerging artists at an early stage of their career development with projects that will advance their career. No match requirements.

INDIVIDUAL ARTIST: ESTABLISHED CAREER

Provides up to **\$7,000** to aid established career artists in the advanced stage of their career development with projects that will advance their career. No match requirements.

INDIVIDUAL ARTIST: COMMUNITY COLLABORATION

Provides up to **\$10,000** to artists to create a major new work while collaborating with the community, introducing community members to the arts in a new way. No match requirements.
